Port of Nanaimo advises that:

Terra Remote Sensing Inc. with the sonar vessel the *Doppler*, will be conducting an ROV inspection from just south of Good Point on Protection Island crossing the harbour to the Seaplane Access Only entrance just South of the Fishing Pier and return to Good Point on Protection Island.

The transits will take place on **Wednesday, January 23rd** between 0900 hours and 1300 hours (PDT) as follows:

Start just south of Good Point on Protection Island at
49° 10.580'N 123° 55.415'W

Turning point just south of the Fishing Pier at
49° 10.212'N 123° 56.211'W

Returning to Good Point on Protection Island at
49° 10.580'N 123° 55.415'W

The survey vessel will transit the Aircraft Only entrance on both crossings. NPA Osprey will assist aircraft through the Boat Access Only area when the vessel is impeding safe passage. The vessel is expected to be in the Seaplane Access area between 1030 – 1110 hours.
